must remain vigilant and keep a safe distance from each other, and do not linger outside after viewing. We ask that you keep this in mind when viewing.

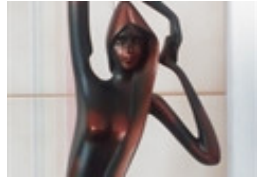
Family and friends are asked to meet on Saturday at Mt. Pleasant Cemetery at 10:30am.
