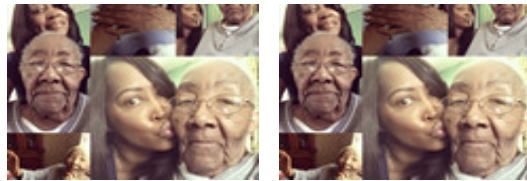
Mrs. Pugh will repose in the Chestnut Memorial Chapel on Thursday, April 9th, 2020 from 2:00pm until 7:00pm.
