August 3, 1952 - September 5, 2022

Neddra Price-Crowell passed away Monday September 5, 2022.

She was born on August 3, 1952 in Gainesville, FL to Evans Price and Alma Plummer-Crowell.

Neddra was baptized at Old Mount Carmel Baptist Church and accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior as a child. She attended Duval Elementary, Lincoln High School and graduated from Waycross High School in 1971. Neddra went on to attend Santa Fe Community College and the University of Wyoming graduating with a Bachelors degree in Political Science in 1975.

After college, she went on to become one of the first few female black Law Enforcement Officers in Waycross, GA. Neddra later returned to live in Gainesville, FL where she resided for the last 30 plus years before going home to glory.

She was preceded in death by her son Christopher Jenkins, and sister Marcia Clayton.

Neddra leaves to mourn two sons, Andre' Price and Floyd Jenkins Jr.; one daughter, Nedra Brown; brother, Ronald Crowell (Ann); seven grandchildren, one great grandchild and a host of nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.
